'A Rush Of Hope' Cinematic Greg Laurie Faith Event Coming In August

Greg Laurie, founder and lead pastor of Harvest Churches and Harvest Crusades, has announced the release of "<u>A Rush of Hope</u>," a one-of-a-kind cinematic crusade coming in September of 2020.

"A Rush of Hope" is Harvest's creative response to the Covid-19 pandemic, which forced the ministry to cancel its in-person crusades scheduled this year at Anaheim's Angel Stadium.

"We've never done anything like this before," Laurie said. "The Covid-19 pandemic has completely changed all our plans, but it has opened an incredible window of opportunity for the gospel. Now, more than ever, people are hungry for something the world cannot give them. This cinematic crusade is designed to reach as many people as possible and help them answer the deepest questions of their hearts."
